

Health, Safety & Environment Committee

Specific Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Acts in an advisory role to the MEC Officers on safety matters
2. Studies air safety and health problems and prepares recommendations to be presented to the MEC Officers for consideration
3. Reviews material, handles correspondence, and keeps the Members well informed of current safety developments. Provides information to the Communications Committee for inclusion in Union communications.
4. Attends management debriefings when safety related issues are discussed

The HSE Committee will help cabin crew with:

- Concerns or reports of safety, health, or security hazards onboard the aircraft and in other work locations
- Obtaining resources and information from the AFA International Air Safety, Health, & Security Department
- Filling out Safety reports
