Health, Safety & Environment Committee

Specific Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Acts in an advisory role to the MEC Officers on safety matters
- 2. Studies air safety and health problems and prepares recommendations to be presented to the MEC Officers for consideration
- 3. Reviews material, handles correspondence, and keeps the Members well informed of current safety developments. Provides information to the Communications Committee for inclusion in Union communications.
- 4. Attends management debriefings when safety related issues are discussed

The HSE Committee will help cabin crew with:

- Concerns or reports of safety, health, or security hazards onboard the aircraft and in other work locations
- Obtaining resources and information from the AFA International Air Safety, Health, & Security Department
- Filling out Safety reports
